MEDIA RELEASE: PSC Seeks Comments in Docket Pertaining to the Electrification of South Carolina's Transportation Sector

Columbia, South Carolina--The Public Service Commission of South Carolina (PSC) is seeking comments in [Commission Docket No. 2023-121-E](#), which relates to the identification of regulatory challenges and opportunities associated with electrification of the transportation sector pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-265.

The Commission will consider the need for a public hearing in this case based on the comments filed in the Docket.

Stakeholders can participate in this docket in one of several ways:

Option A: File a Petition to Intervene. An Intervenor becomes a party in the case. Intervenors have the right to testify, cross-examine witnesses, appeal the Commission's Final Decision, and must follow the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. To intervene, you must:

- Email a Petition to Intervene to contact@psc.sc.gov no later than **Friday, July 21, 2023**; or
- Mail a Petition to Intervene to 101 Executive Center Drive, Suite 100, Columbia, SC 29210 no later than **Friday, July 21, 2023**. Please include your email address.

****You must give a copy of your Petition to Intervene to all Parties in this case. Petitions to Intervene must meet the requirements of Commission Regulation 103-825 and must be approved by the Commission.**

Option B: Intervenors who want to file verified comments to assist the Commission in making a determination related to the electrification of the transportation sector as outlined in S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-265 and the measures to promote electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates as outlined in 16 U.S.C. 2621(d)(21) must file verified comments no later than **Friday, July 28, 2023**. Responsive verified comments must be filed no later than **Tuesday, August 8, 2023**.

Option C: File a Letter of Protest by

- Emailing contact@psc.sc.gov; or
- Mailing the completed Letter of Protest to 101 Executive Center Drive, Suite 100, Columbia, SC 29210.

Option D: Interested stakeholders, who are not intervenors, who want to file comments to assist the Commission in making a determination related to the electrification of the transportation sector as outlined in S.C. Code Ann. Section 58-27-265 and the measures to promote electrification of the transportation sector, including the establishment of rates as outlined in 16 U.S.C. 2621(d)(21) must file comments no later than **Friday, July 28, 2023**. Responsive comments must be filed no later than **Tuesday, August 8, 2023**.
